Portable Health Clinic (PHC) aims to build an affordable, usable and sustainable preventive healthcare system for people located in remote rural regions in the world. The project has been implemented in several developing countries led by the Grameen Group and Yunus Centre across Bangladesh and Japan. While mHealth has been the term used for making healthcare access possible in remote locations using mobile phones, there have been many evolving models on the sustainability of mHealth all over the world. This session will discuss some of these initiatives with a view to deploy PHC widely in the Belt and Road Region and countries.
